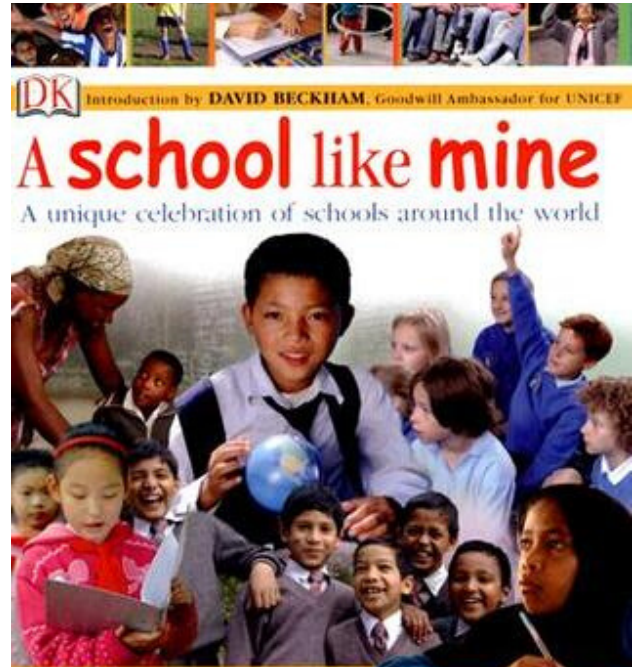




A SCHOOL LIKE MINE

Questions:

Read each page and ask the following questions.

1. Talk about the things students have in common with these others students around the world.
2. What is different?
3. Are our similarities or differences more important?
4. Is there anything they have or do that might be interesting or fun to try?

ACTIVITY:

Try playing some of the games that they play in other places or doing some of the art projects. See which ones are fun!

Talk about the various foods from other cultures and places. What ones sound delicious? What ones would you be nervous about tasting? Would you try them anyway?
