Questions:

- 2. Why do all those people want to drink water?
- 3. Why do they use different kinds of containers?
- 4. Why do so many people in different people from different places carry the water containers on their heads? What parts of your body would hurt while carrying water on your head?
- 5. AT THE BACK OF THE BOOK: Read about each of the pictures and the places that they were taken. What would it be like to live in each of those places?
