



ACCORDION FLOWERS

Lesson of the Day:

Flowers come in hundreds of shapes, sizes and colors. In fact, no two are exactly alike! Does that make one better or more beautiful than another? No! People are just the same- we may all be different shapes, sizes, and colors on the outside, but all of us are beautiful inside. And all of us need to be taken care of to make sure we grow as strong, healthy, and amazing as we can be.



Materials:

- Colorful construction paper
- Glue
- Popsicle sticks
- Scissors
- Markers



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Fold four rectangles of construction paper accordion-style. Glue or tape the edges together to form a circle.
3. Glue a flower shape and/or a circle in yellow, orange, or black in the center.
4. Have students color a popsicle stick green to look like a stem. Glue the flower to the top of the popsicle stick. Students can also glue on leaves if desired.
