ADORABLE PAPER OWLS

Lesson of the Day:

Owls have huge eyes that help them to spot even the tiniest insect.

Keep your eyes wide open! If you see someone who is hurting, make sure you take care of them and help them to feel better. If you see someone being bullied, help to stop the person who is hurting them or help them get away to where they feel safe.

Materials:

- Brown construction paper
- Tan construction paper
- Yellow construction paper

Instructions:

- Orange construction paper
- Black construction paper
- Glue
- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students work together to rip up brown paper and make a pile.
- 3. Have students cut large yellow circles and small black circles.
- 4. Have students cut orange rectangles for the feet and orange triangles for the owl.
- 5. Give students glue to create an owl on their paper. Remind them to think of what owls' ears look like and to try to keep the owls' body shape.
