Lesson of the Day:

Materials:

- Paint
- Star stickers
- Paper
- Other decorations

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Help students choose a color for their eagle's body and place a footprint in that color in the center of the paper. Make sure their heel is painted white rather than the color of the rest of the body, with their toes painted a color for the feet.
- 3. Have students place a handprint wing the same color as their eagle's body.
- 4. Have students add a small dot of black paint for the eye and paint an orange beak.
- 5. Allow them to add star stickers or other decorations to enhance their picture.
