Lesson of the Day:

If we love our country, we want it to be the best place it can be. That starts with us.

Always do your best to be kind, generous, and respectful of people around you, even if they are different from you. One of the things that makes our country special is that there are so many different kinds of people living and working together.



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks
- Hot glue
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.

Markers

• White and orange paper

- 2. Before class starts, hot glue several popsicle or craft sticks together by cutting a popsicle stick in half and gluing each half to the back of a row of other popsicle sticks, one half toward the top and the other half toward the bottom. Add a stick coming down for students to hold.
- 3. Have students color the eagle however they would like. Have them cut out the eagle's head and trace their hands and cut them out for wings.
- 4. Have students glue everything together, including the orange beak. Make sure they include eyes!
