



BEAD SUNFLOWERS

Lesson of the Day:

Sunflowers are known for their large, striped seeds. When those seeds get planted, more sunflowers grow. We need to plant positive seeds of kindness and light that will continue to grow in the future.

We plant those seeds by being kind and caring for all of those around us.



Materials:

- Yellow construction paper
- Green construction paper
- Black pony beads
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut out yellow paper into the shape of petals.
 - a. You can also have them affix yellow tissue paper to pre-cut petals
3. Have students glue the petals and a green rectangle stem to their paper.
4. In the center of the flower, have students glue down pony bead “seeds”
