


BLANK SPACE HEART PAINTINGS

Lesson of the Day:

Sometimes it's not the things we do and say, but the things we DON'T do and say that leave an impression. If we don't show people that we love them and care about them, they might not know. We have to make sure to show people that we care and to tell them just how much we love them.



Materials:

- Cardstock
- Paint
- Paper

- Scissors
- Tape
- Paintbrushes



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut out a heart shape. If possible, have them cut out an outline of a heart.
- 3. Have them tape the heart outline to another piece of paper.
- 4. Once it is secure, have them carefully paint the paper over the top of the cutout. When they are finished painting, have them carefully remove the cutout from the paper. There should be a blank space left behind where the outline was.
- 5. Once the paint is dried, they can write a note to someone in the blank space left behind.
