

BUTTON RAINBOW

Lesson of the Day:

Appreciate the rainbows when they come! Make sure to take the time to notice all the good, beautiful things in your life and be grateful that they're there. Be grateful for your friends, you family, and all the other people who love you. Be grateful for all the people you love. Be grateful for all the people who help you, and pay it forward by helping others!

Materials:

- Rainbow colored buttons
- Cotton balls
- Paper
- Glitter glue





Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students draw a rainbow shape onto the paper with each stripe wide enough for the buttons.
- 3. Have them glue the buttons to the correct stripe of the rainbow using glitter glue. This should give it some extra shine and sparkle!
- 4. When they're done, have them glue cotton balls to the ends of the rainbow in the shape of clouds.
- 5. If there's time and space, have them draw a sun at the top.
