



CATCH THE BEAD

Lesson of the Day:

When you first try to catch the bead in the cup, it might be a bit difficult. But if you keep trying and working at it, you'll be able to do it! If you practice a lot, you might even start to find it pretty easy. Practicing just about everything will make you better at it! So keep it up! You can do it!



Materials:

- Paper cup
- Pencil
- String
- Hot glue gun
- Decorations
- Glue
- Markers
- Bead



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students decorate their cup. They can color it with markers, glue ribbons around it, add sequins or glitter glue... whatever decorations you want to allow them!
3. Once they have decorated the cup, punch a hole around the rim and tie the end of the string to it.
4. Tie the other end of the string around the bead. Make sure the string is long enough to get into the cup with a decent amount of slack.
5. Hot glue the pencil to the center of the bottom of the cup.
6. Play and have fun!
