

CHINESE DRUM/NOISEMAKER

Lesson of the Day:

When we celebrate things, we have to shout them from the rooftops! Make some noise! Be happy! If something makes you happy and you enjoy it- let the whole world know! And if you're respecting other people at the same time, so much the better!

Materials:

- Paper plates
- Sticks
- Thin ribbon
- Bells
- Dry beans/pasta
- Paper
- Markers
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students color the outside of their two plates red with markers.
- 3. Have students draw and/or color various Chinese symbols, like the dragon, fans, pagodas, etc.
- 4. Have students tie their bells onto the ends of the ribbon. Glue the other end of the ribbon inside the paper plates. Hot glue it if necessary.
- 5. Glue the two plates together, putting the stick inside at the bottom.
- 6. If desired: put beans or uncooked pasta between the two plates to make extra noise.
