



CLOTHESPIN BIRDS

Lesson of the Day:

When people are being mean and you don't want to be in that situation anymore, fly away. You don't have to stay around people who aren't being nice. You can take a friend and fly away. If someone is being mean to another kid, whether that kid is your friend or not, you can also help them by flying away together.



Materials:



- Feathers
- Clothespins
- Markers
- Construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Optional: Wood/cardstock

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students color a clothespin to match the kind of bird they want to make.
3. Have them add a beak and small googly eyes to the clothespin to make a face.
4. Students can then add feathers to the back of the clothespin.
5. Hot glue the clothespin to a small piece of wood or cardstock to help it stand, if desired
