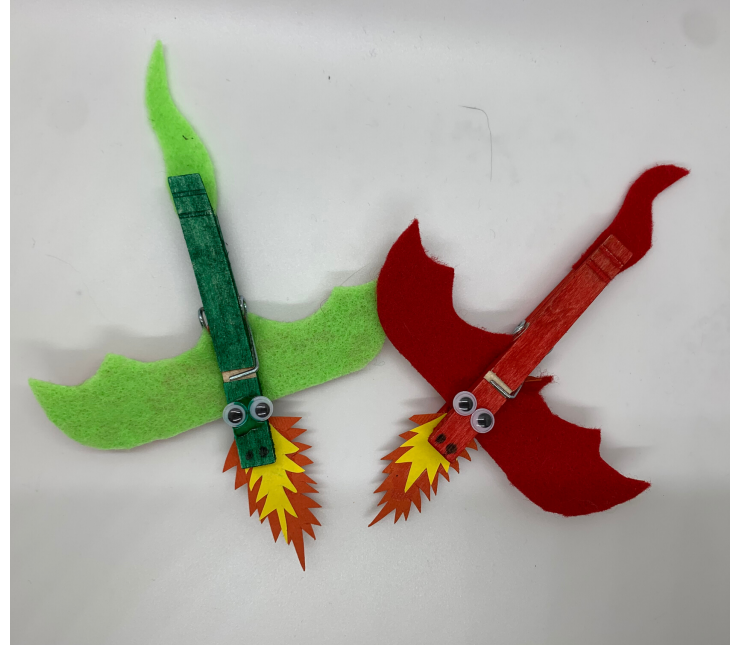




# CLOTHESPIN DRAGONS

## Lesson of the Day:

Dragons breathe fire. What would happen if they breathed fire on someone? That person would get hurt. We have to make sure that we don't breathe fire on people around us with our words. We don't want to hurt them by saying something mean. Make sure all the words that come out of your mouth are kind.



## Materials:

- Paper
- Clothespins
- Markers
- Craft foam, paper, or felt
- Glue
- Googly eyes
- Scissors



## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students color their clothespins the color they want their dragon to be. Have them color nostrils and glue googly eyes on.
3. Have students cut flames and wings out of different colors of craft foam.
4. Have students cut a tail out of construction paper. If they want to add texture to the tail, they can fold the paper tightly in an accordion style.
