



CLOTHESPIN GIRAFFES

Lesson of the Day:

Giraffes have long necks and are so tall that they can see everything happening around them. Try to keep an eye on what's happening around you and if something is going wrong, help make it right.

Materials:

- Clothespins
- Paint
- Yarn
- Card stock
- Puffballs
- Googly eyes
- Scissors



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students paint three clothespins each yellow with brown spots.
3. Have students cut a rectangle out of cardstock and paint it yellow with brown spots as well.
4. While that dries, have students glue small googly eyes to a yellow puffball.
5. Glue very short pieces of yarn to two thin strips of paper.
6. Color the ear and feet tips of the clothespins black. Assemble the giraffe. Glue the short yarn paper strips to the inside of the clothespin opposite the head.
