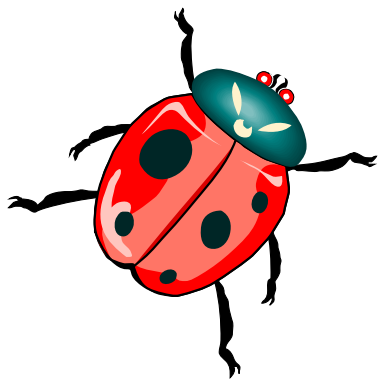




# CLOTHESPIN INSECTS

## Lesson of the Day:

## Materials:

- Clothespins
- Paint
- Markers
- Glue
- Buttons (optional)
- Sequins (optional)
- Glitter glue (optional)
- Puffballs (optional)
- Jewels (optional)
- Construction paper
- Pipe cleaners (optional)

## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students paint or color clothespins.
3. Then have them add details to make their very own insects. How many legs? Do they fly?
4. They can add paper wings, buttons, sequins, glitter, jewels, puffballs, pipe cleaners, etc. to make their insect special and unique.
