



CLOTHESPIN PEACOCK

Lesson of the Day:

There is a famous saying: As proud as a peacock. We should always make sure that we are proud of ourselves whenever we do something good. We often get mad at ourselves when we make a mistake, but we don't celebrate our victories. Be proud of yourself! You are amazing. Be proud of your friends, too.



Materials:

- Paper
- Clothespin
- Paint
- Yarn
- Construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students make a fan on white paper. Have them open the paper back up and paint it with many colors, like a peacock's tail.
3. While it dries, have students make the peacock's body out of construction paper. Include eyes, wings, and a beak.
4. When the fan is dry, put the end into a clothespin. Wrap yarn tightly around it so that the fan doesn't fall out. Glue the peacock body to the fan/tail.
