

CREATE A COOKIE

Lesson of the Day:

Everybody likes different things. Some people like chocolate cookies, some people don't like chocolate anything. Some people like oatmeal raisin and others don't like raisins at all. Just because someone likes different things from us, doesn't mean we're completely different and cannot be friends. In fact, if your friend doesn't like chocolate, it just means more chocolate for you!



Materials:

- Cardboard circles
- Sprinkles
- Buttons
- Foam/paper shapes

- Glitter glue
- Paint
- Markers

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Cut circles out of cardboard. It can be from an old box in order to use recycled/reused materials.
- 3. Give each student some circles. Give them random decorations to decorate their cookies. They can add anything they want, just like in real life cookies!
- 4. Encourage students to use their imagination and creativity to make many different kinds of cookies!
