

CUPCAKE PAPER FLOWERS

Lesson of the Day:

A little sunshine helps things grow. If you're kind to those around you and only shine light on all the wonderful things they do, they will grow to do those wonderful things more often. If we are mean to people, it won't teach them to grow beautifully. It will make them afraid to grow at all.



Materials:

- Variety of cupcake papers
- Glue
- Glitter
- Popsicle sticks



- White paper
- Scissors
- Markers
- Paper plate

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students separate the cupcake liners. They can cut them to make petals or leave them whole. They can decorate the flowers with markers if they would like.
- 3. Have them place the liners in size order to make flowers. Have them glue the flowers together in this order, adding glitter to the center if they would like.
- 4. Have students decorate their paper plate vase and gather their green popsicle sticks (have them color plain popsicle sticks if necessary). Have them glue everything together on the paper.
