



DANDELION WISH PICTURES

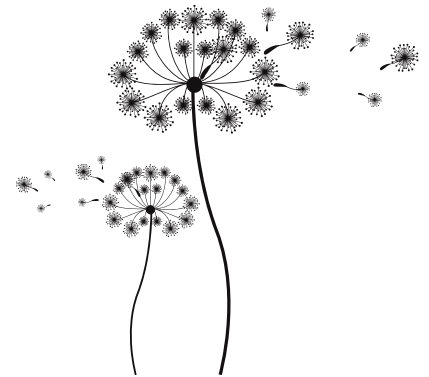
Lesson of the Day:

Materials:

- Paper
- Markers/colored pencils
- Glue
- Cotton balls



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Draw a picture of what you wish for. Maybe you have a wish for your family to get a new home, or do a certain job when you grow up. Maybe you wish that everyone on earth would have enough food or be free to be safe and happy. The sky's the limit!
3. Pull apart the cotton balls so the cotton is thin and wispy and looks a bit like dandelion seeds. Glue little bits of the cotton on top of the picture as if it's the dandelion wish.
4. Do whatever you can to make your wish come true!
