

DAY OF THE DEAD SKELETONS

Lesson of the Day:

A lot of people love to dance!
Sometimes people are really good at dancing and sometimes they aren't.

Materials:

- Skeleton template
- Cardstock
- Colored Pencils
- Markers
- Brads
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Hole Punch
- StringNeedle







Instructions:


- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut out all the skeleton shapes they want to include on their puppet.
- 3. Have them color all the accessories and skeletons as desired. Glue the accessories to the actual skeleton puppet.
- 4. Hole punch all the appropriate spots on the puppets and assemble using brads.
- 5. To make the puppets dance, use the needles and string to sew through the small block holes and connect all the arms and legs to the string. Pulling the string should move the arms and legs.







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
