

## **DREAMCATCHER**

## Lesson of the Day:

Dreams don't come true through the magic of wishing. You have to do the work! Work hard to make your dreams come true and get where you want to be. And, if at all possible, always look for opportunities to help someone else make their dream come true

## **Materials:**

- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Beads
- Feathers
- Glitter Glue/Markers

## Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have kids cut a hole in the center of their plate. The easiest way is to fold the plate in half and cut a half circle from the center. Decorate the plate with markers.
- 3. Hole punch around the center hole. Weave a long piece of yarn back and forth through those holes, letting the extra hang down.
- 4. Add beads to the yarn and tie a feather to the end of each extra piece.
- 5. Add more decorations to the plate!

TEACHER HINT: This is a project best for older students. Hole punch before, and do the weaving ahead of time for young students.
