

ELF HATS

Lesson of the Day:

We can all be helpers to someone! Sometimes when adults or our friends are working on a big project they can't do everything by themselves. We can help them with a lot of different things. It may be a little thing to help with or a lot, but it could make all the difference in the world to them. Always do your best to help someone when you can!





Materials:

- Green Construction paper
- Staples/Tape
- Skin tone paper for ears
- Markers
- Cotton
- Decorations



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. With a piece of construction paper, fold down two of the corners until they meet, making a triangle and leaving a thin strip of paper at the bottom. Cut off that strip.
- 3. Staple or tape the edges together and make the hat into a cone.
- 4. Have the kids create ears and staple them to the sides of the hat.
- 5. Give each student a large piece of cotton to glue to the top.
- 6. Allow students time to decorate their elf hat however they would like.
