



FATHER'S DAY CARD

Lesson of the Day:

A father is a person who loves you and supports you in everything you do. If you have a father who's there for you, make sure you let him know how much you appreciate him. If your father is not a part of your life, think of the people in your life who are there to support you and care for you. Maybe it's your mom. Or your uncle. Or a neighbor, a family friend. Whoever it is, make sure they know how much you appreciate them.



Materials:

- Cardstock (multiple pages)
- Masking tape/Painter's tape
- Paint (various colors)

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Cut out cardstock in the shape of the letters D-A-D. Tape them to another piece of cardstock from the underside (so the tape doesn't muss the edges). If you use regular construction paper, the tape may rip the paper when removed.
3. Have kids paint on top of the letters, getting paint onto the paper below. Try to get them to use their dad's favorite colors!
4. Remove the taped letters before the paint dries.
