

FINGER PAINTED POT OF GOLD

Lesson of the Day:

Figure out what you want and go for it! Maybe it's a pot of gold, maybe it's to have a certain job, or maybe it's just to find a great group of friends that are fun to be around and who support you. Whatever it is that you want, you should work hard to get it, and hope that there is a pot of gold at the end of your rainbow path!



Materials:

- Printable (attached)
- Paint in rainbow colors



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Give each student a template.
- 3. Have them paint the picture using their fingers. They can paint the pot black or dark grey, the shamrocks green, and the gold yellow (or gold, if you have it).
- 4. Have students paint the rainbow in four colors of the rainbow in a row (red, orange, yellow, and green or yellow, green, blue, and purple, etc.)



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
