

FINGERPRINT BUNNY

Lesson of the Day:

Bunnies are gentle animals who very easily get scared. They're also soft, cuddly, and sweet. But if we're too loud or aggressive with the bunnies, we will scare them and chase them away. Sometimes people are like that too. Some people are very gentle

and can get scared easily. We have to be extra kind to be their friends.

Materials:



- White paper
- Tape
- Pastel colored paint



- Cotton balls
- Glue
- Markers

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut out a bunny shape. They can then tape it securely to the middle of their paper.
- 3. Using their fingers, they will then paints a scene around the bunny- green grass, blue sky, flowers, etc. They can also just paint with all different colors and make a beautiful pattern. They should cover the whole paper, including the cut out bunny.
- 4. Remove the bunny cut out to show the shape that's left behind.
- 5. Once the paint is dry, have the students glue on a cotton ball for the tail and draw a face on the bunny.
