

FINGERPRINT TREE

Lesson of the Day:

When you are kind to yourself and build roots with a lot of love and care for you, it makes it easier to be kind to the people you reach your branches out to. So be kind to yourself!



Materials:

- Green paint in various shades
- White paper
- Brown markers
- Black markers



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students draw and color a large, strong tree trunk on their paper.
- 3. Have them paint their fingers in various shades of green, red, and orange, and place fingerprints at the top of the tree trunk.
- Once the paint is all dried, have students copy the phrase "Strong roots make beautiful leaves". If they can't copy things down quite yet, have them trace it.
