

FLOATING DOT BOOKMARKS

Lesson of the Day:

It's important to take care of people's hearts, but also to take care of their minds. Reading is an important way to take care of yourself and to learn about how others feel.

So read! Read about people who are different from you and learn about them!



Materials:

- Cardstock
- Colorful paper
- Clear contact paper
- Scissors

- Hole punch
- Sequins
- Ribbon

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Use the hole punch to make many colorful dots. You can fold over tissue paper or construction paper to make multiple dots at once.
- 3. Hand out bookmark borders cut from cardstock. Stick them to a piece of large clear contact paper (larger than the border).
- 4. Let kids put dots and sequins all over the contact paper in whatever pattern they would like.
- 5. Place another piece of contact paper over the top to seal the dots in. Cut off the excess contact paper outside the bookmark border. You can punch another hole and add some ribbon to the top.
