FOOTPRINT ROCKET

Lesson of the Day:

When we love someone, what will we do for them? Anything they need and anything we can. We love them to the ends of the earth, to the moon and back. We work hard to show them how much we love them.

Materials:



- Paint
- Paper
- Construction paper
- Star stickers (optional)
- Glitter Glue (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Paint the bottom of each child's foot the color they want their rocket to be and have them step onto a piece of paper (can be white or black) to leave a footprint.
- 3. Have each student glue on the tip and fins of the rocket, which can be pre-cut from construction paper or which they can cut out themselves.
- 4. Have students add stars and construction paper fire to the picture. They can add more details if they would like, such as painting on smaller stars or adding glitter glue to their picture.
- 5. Have students glue on puffball "windows" to their rocket
