



FRIENDSHIP FLOWERS

Lesson of the Day:

Friendship is important to being happy. But an important part in having strong friendships is not only choosing people who are good friends to you, but being a good friend to them. What makes a good friend? Work on being the best friend you can be and you'll find lots of friends everywhere you go!



Materials:

- Construction paper
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Cut out petals from the construction paper and glue them onto the background paper. Glue a yellow or orange circle in the middle.
3. Add a green stem and petal below the flower.
4. Write the word "Friends" at the top of the page.
5. Talk about and think about what makes someone a good friend. Do they have to be funny or is it more important to be kind? Write something that is important in a friend on each petal. You can also write about a specific friend!
