



FUZZY WINTER HATS

Lesson of the Day:

Hats cover our ears to keep them warm when it's cold outside. When people we care about talk, we don't want to cover our ears. We want to listen as best we can, especially when they're talking about how they feel or what they need.



Materials:

- Cotton Balls
- Paint
- Construction paper



- Scissors
- Yarn
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut out a hat shape from construction paper.
3. Have them fingerpaint colorful spots or patterns onto the hat.
4. Have students glue down cotton balls to the bottom band of the hat to make it warmer.
5. Have students cut short strings of yarn in whatever colors they want. Have them tie a piece of yarn around the middle of the other yarn. Fan out the ends of the yarn to make it more of a circle shape. Have students glue this to the top of the hat.
