



GINGERBREAD PEOPLE

Lesson of the Day:

Has anyone heard the story of the gingerbread man? He tries to run away from his friends and listens to strangers. While all strangers are not bad people, we still have to be careful who we listen to. We should always be kind to everyone, but that doesn't mean that we should always trust strangers.



Materials:

- Brown construction paper
- Glitter/glitter glue
- Sequins
- Glue
- Decorations



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Help students draw (or hand out pre-traced) gingerbread man and woman shapes on brown construction paper. Have them cut out the gingerbread people.
3. Have students decorate their gingerbread people however they like, with glitter or glitter glue, sequins, and other decorations.
4. Talk about how everyone's gingerbread people will look different, just like real people.
5. If time allows, have students make more than one gingerbread person.
