



GROWING HANDPRINT BOUQUET

Lesson of the Day:

A bouquet with only one color of flowers can be beautiful, but a bit boring. A bouquet with all the colors under the sun, on the other hand, is always an interesting, beautiful thing. It is what makes us different that makes us even more beautiful when we work together.



Materials:

- Paint
- Paper
- Markers



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students draw and color a flower pot on a large piece of white paper.
3. Have them paint their hands in various colors and make handprints above the flower pot. They should do two in each color before washing their hand to paint it a new color.
4. After the paint has dried, let them draw stems with a paintbrush. They can also add decorations to their flower pots with paint as well.
