

HANDPRINT FISH PUPPETS

Lesson of the Day:


Fish have a face where it looks like they're always running around looking for a kiss, right? We shouldn't kiss people at school, but we can show them that we care about them. How can we show that? We can give hugs, we can say nice things, and we can play together as friends.



Materials:

- Construction paper
- Popsicle/craft sticks
- Googly eyes

- Glitter glue
- Sequins
- Glue



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students trace their hands on construction paper and cut them out. Have them cut hearts out of construction paper for the fish's mouths and glue this on the hand, along with the googly eyes.
- 3. Let them add decorations like glitter glue or sequins to make their fish different from everyone else's.
- 4. Glue the handprint fish to a craft stick to make it a puppet!
