

HANDPRINT KITTIES

Lesson of the Day:

Some people say cats have nine lives. We only have one life, and we have to live it the best way we can. What should we do to make sure our life is a happy one?

Should we live it with kindness and make as many friends as we can? Should we help take care of others, or think only of ourselves?





Materials:

- Construction paper (black, brown, orange)
- Google eyes
- Colored pencils

- Glue
- Scissors
- Optional: Glitter/glitter glue

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students trace their hand on a piece of paper that is black, brown, orange, or some other colors that cats are. When they have traced it, they will cut it out.
- 3. Have students cut out a circle and two triangles in the same color as they cut out their hands. Have them glue it to the base of the hand in the shape of a cat's head.
- 4. Have the students add details like a face, whiskers, and google eyes. Glitter whiskers are always cute!
