



HANDPRINT BOUQUET

Lesson of the Day:

We can hold the hands of people we care about to show them our support. In fact, lending someone a hand and helping them out is one of the best ways to show someone we care. We want to make sure that we show people that we love just how much we care about them every day, but especially on Valentine's Day.

Materials:

- Paper
- Paint
- Paintbrushes
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students paint their hands and put handprints onto their original paper. When the handprints have dried, have students cut them out.
3. Have students paint stems and a ribbon onto a second piece of paper.
4. Once it is all dry, have students glue down the handprints at the top of the stems as though they are flowers. Have them copy down "Happy Valentines Day" and other similar messages from the board.
