

HANDPRINT TREES

Lesson of the Day:

We have to reach out our hands and work together to get great things done. No one can do things all on their own all the time. So reach out! Shake someone's hand, hold their hand, or pat them on the back to let them know you are there for them. And, if you need it, don't be afraid to reach out your hand to ask for help.

Materials:

- Red construction paper
- Orange construction paper
- Yellow construction paper
- Brown construction paper



- Toilet paper roll
- Paper plate
- Green markers/paint
- Glue

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students color or paint a paper plate green.
- 3. Have students glue a toilet paper roll to their green paper plate.
- 4. Have students wrap brown paper around the toilet roll to make up the trunk and add branches.
- 5. Have students trace their hands on paper that is many different fall colors.
- 6. Have students cut out their hands and glue them to the branches of their toilet roll tree.
