

HANDPRINT WINTER BIRDS

Lesson of the Day:

Are there a lot of birds around in the winter time? Why not? Just like birds need a warm environment, people need a warm environment as well. Materials:

- Blue construction paper
- Red paint
- Brown paint



- White paint
- Orange paint
- Black paint
- Snowflake Stickers

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students paint their hands with red paint and put two handprints on the paper with their fingers together. Have them paint a brown branch below each handprint.
- 3. Have students add white paint to the branches as snow.
- 4. Have students add an orange feet and a beak and one black eye.
- 5. Students can decorate with snowflakes and other little details.
