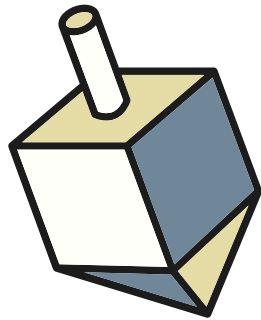
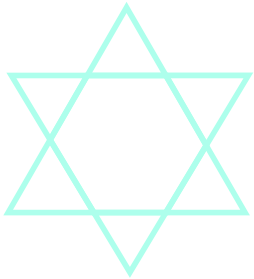




HANNUKAH SUNCATCHERS

Lesson of the Day:

Learning about other cultures can bring a lot of light into our lives. We can see things differently and it can also add a lot of beauty. Make sure you respect other people's differences, are open-minded to learning new things, and care about people.



Materials:

- Popsicle sticks
- Tissue paper
- Tin foil
- Watered down glue
- Beads
- Jewelry wire
- Window suction cups

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Hot glue together popsicle sticks into the desired shapes.
3. Lay down a piece of tin foil under each student's popsicle stick shape. Use the watered down glue to stick tissue paper to the popsicle stick frame, making sure the center space is fully covered.
4. While that dries, have students put beads onto the jewelry wire.
5. Once the glue dries, attach the wire to the art work. Attach the other side to the rubber suction cup for the window.
