

HATCHING CHICK

Lesson of the Day:

You never know what might be on the inside just from how something looks from the outside. No matter what the outside of something or someone looks like, inside could be something sweet and delicate that you should be gentle with.



Materials:

- Two paper plates per student
- Markers
- Yellow and orange felt
- Google eyes

- Yellow feathers
- Stapler
- Brads

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students decorate the outside of one paper plate like an Easter Egg.
- 3. Have students cut that paper plate in half in whatever pattern they want.
- 4. On the inside of the other paper plate, have students make a chick using yellow felt and feathers. Have them add a beak and google eyes as well.
- 5. Staple the bottom of the broken egg to the regular egg. Attach the top half of the broken egg using a brad.
