

HATCHING DINOSAUR

Lesson of the Day:

Don't be afraid to come out of your shell! It can be scary to be vulnerable to others, and sometimes they might make fun of you. But when you come out of your shell you will meet some amazing people who will love you just as you are! When you see others coming out of their shells, be kind and help them to see what acceptance and friendship feel like.



Materials:

- Cardstock
- Markers
- Glitter glue
- Brad

- Printout
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students cut a large egg shape out of their piece of cardstock and cut it in half jaggedly however they want.
- 3. Have them color the dinosaur printout and cut it out.
- 4. Let students decorate the egg however they want with markers, glitter glue and more. Let them get creative!
- 5. Have students glue the dinosaur to the back of the bottom of the egg.
- 6. Using a brad, attach the two halves of the egg shell so that it can open and close easily.
