

HAVE YOU FILLED A BUCKET? BUCKETS

Lesson of the Day:

Read <u>Have You Filled a Bucket</u> <u>Today?</u> with your class. Talk about the way the characters in the book treated one another. Talk about all the different people and things in their lives that help make them feel happy.

We need to help other people fill their buckets. Being kind and giving people compliments helps them to have full buckets. Let's do it!

Materials:

- Red solo cup
- Pipe cleaner
- Markers
- Stickers



- Paper
- Hole puncher
- Glitter glue

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Put a hole in each side of the red solo cup.
- 3. Have students create a handle using a pipe cleaner through the holes in the cup.
- 4. Have the students decorate the cups with markers, stickers, and glitter glue.
- 5. Have students write their names on the buckets.
- 6. Have students write compliments and good memories of one another to put in each others' buckets.
