



HEART BOUQUETS

Lesson of the Day:

Take the time to make something for someone. Then not only do they get a beautiful gift, but they also know that you put thought, time, and love into what you are giving them. Parents, grandparents, and other family members especially appreciate getting handcrafted gifts.



Materials:

- Colorful paper
- Pipe cleaners
- Tissue paper
- Glitter glue
- Scissors
- Glue
- Decorations

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut out several large hearts from all different colors of paper, but pink and red are generally great colors for this project.
3. Have them ball up small pieces of tissue paper and glue them in the middle of some of the hearts.
4. Have them use glitter glue and other decorations to make others beautiful as well.
5. Have them glue (or you can hot glue) pipe cleaner stems to the back of their heart “flowers”. Let them make as many as they want and decorate them however they’d like!
