



LAYERED HANDPRINT TURKEYS

Lesson of the Day:

Every year, the president pardons a turkey and saves it from becoming dinner.

Pardoning means to forgive.

Have you ever forgiven someone before? Why is it important to forgive people when they make mistakes?



Materials:

- Various colors of felt
- Glue

- Scissors
- Markers



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students trace their hand on a piece of felt. Have them cut out that traced hand.
3. Have them put that hand on another piece of felt and trace around it, leaving space so the next hand will be slightly larger. Have them cut out the second hand.
4. Repeat until each student has between 4 and 6 hand cutouts.
5. Have them glue those hands together from smallest to largest. Have them cut out the additional shapes to make the turkey's body. Glue it all together.
