

LINE PAINTING

Lesson of the Day:

Often people will tell you to stay inside the lines- do what they want you to do and be who they want you to be. Always remember that the great thing about this world is that YOU can CREATE the lines. You can make the world what you want it to be and decide who you want to be and what you want to do.



Materials:

- Canvas
- Painter's tape

- Paint
- Paintbrushes

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have kids put painter's tape on the canvas in whatever pattern they would like. It can be random or they can try to make some sort of pattern.
- 3. Have them paint each shape made by the tape lines a different color. If they want to use the same colors, make sure they try to not color shapes that are next to each other the same color.
- 4. Remove the tape before the paint dries.
- 5. If desired, have them paint, write, or decorate inside the empty canvas space left behind by the tape.
