



THE LORAX AND TRUFFULA TREES

Lesson of the Day:

We have to take good care of the world around us so that the plants and animals can thrive. If we think only about ourselves, we could ruin the earth for those around us, and especially for the people of the future. We want to make sure we leave the world a better place than we found it.



Materials:

- Paper plates
- Various colors of tissue paper
- Yellow construction paper
- Markers
- Popsicle sticks
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paper



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students glue down squares of orange tissue paper to cover the paper plate. Then they will trace their hands on yellow paper and cut them out. Cut out smaller versions of the same shape from the yellow paper as well.
3. Have them glue down the moustache and eyebrows, plus eyes (cut white circles with a black dot in the middle), and a puffball nose.
4. Have them draw three circles on white paper. Have them ball up tissue paper in bright colors and glue it down to the circles.
5. While the glue dries have them decorate popsicle sticks with pink and yellow stripes. Have them glue the circle tops of the trees to the popsicle sticks.
