



LOVE BOMB

Lesson of the Day:

We have to be generous with our love- not only by loving as many people as we can, but by telling them and showing them often. Everyone wants to be loved, and everyone enjoys hearing that others care about them. You may even find that the more love you put out into the world, the more you get back.



Materials:

- paper bags
- White glue
- scrap construction paper
- contact paper
- a canvas
- scissors and/or hole punch



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Cut the scrap paper into tiny pieces to serve as confetti. You can also use a hole punch (or multiple) to make circular confetti.
3. Cut a large heart shape out of contact paper. Place in the center of the canvas.
4. Put glue over the entire canvas, especially around the edges of the heart.
5. You'll want to do this part in an easy-to-clean place. Fill a paper bag with confetti and blow it up full of air. Have students pop the paper bag over the canvas. They will have to shake remaining confetti out of the bag. Push the confetti off the heart in the center.
6. Let dry for a few minutes, then peel off the contact paper heart. Let dry overnight.
