

LOVING LIONS

Lesson of the Day:

Learn to have courage just like the cowardly lion did in The Wizard of Oz! Being brave doesn't mean that you're never scared- it means doing the right thing even if you are scared. Just like this lion, remember to surround yourself with love and it will help you to be brave and do the right thing.



Materials:

- Toilet Roll
- Yellow paper
- Orange paper
- Scissor
- Glue
- Markers
- Googly eyes

Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students wrap their toilet roll in yellow paper and glue it down. Have them cut out the yellow circle for the face and rectangles for the arms and tail.
- 3. Have students cut a lot of heart out of the orange paper. Glue the hearts to the arms as paws and to the tail as the tuft at the end. Glue several into a circle and glue the yellow face in the middle.
- 4. Have students draw the face and glue on googly eyes. Have them put their lion together!

TEACHER HINT: If they can't cut hearts, get creative! Have them glue the face to orange paper and cut whatever mane shape they want!
