


LUCKY SHAMROCKS

Lesson of the Day:

How are you lucky? Most people in the world have at least some ways that they are lucky, whether it's because they have a loving family, live in a great house, have friends who are fun to play with, or a teacher who cares about them and helps them to learn. What are the things about your life that you are lucky for?



Materials:

- White paper
- Green construction paper
- Glue
- Black markers



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have the students draw or trace a four-leaf clover onto green paper.
- 3. Have them copy the words "I am lucky because" at the top of a piece of white paper.
- 4. Have them cut out the clover and glue it on the white paper below the words
- 5. They can then write at least two reasons they are lucky on their clovers, or draw pictures if that's easier. They can also trace words or copy from the board if they are able.
