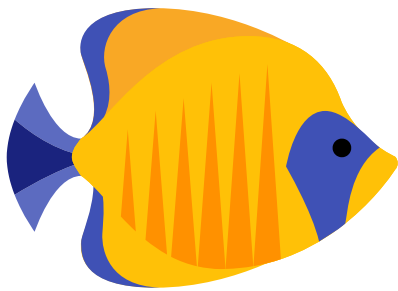
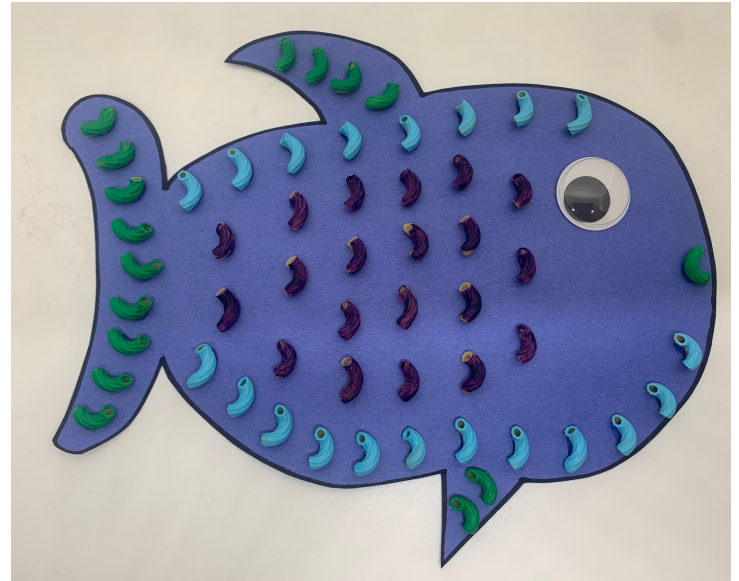




# MACARONI AND PAPER FISH

## Lesson of the Day:

Fish all move at different speeds. Some are fast, some are slow. But it's not a race! Doing things fast can be good, but sometimes going slow so you can do a good job is even better. ## Materials:

- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Glitter glue
- Sequins
- Macaroni pasta
- Paint
- Construction paper
- Glue

## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students paint pieces of macaroni
3. Have them draw and cut fish out of construction paper.
4. Have students glue the macaroni to the paper fish they have just cut out.
5. Have students add details, like googly eyes, glitter glue, and sequins.
