

MARDI GRAS FLOAT

Lesson of the Day:

People put a lot of time and effort into Carnival floats, and they all come out different. Different ideas can all still be very cool and interesting, but you have to put the hard work in to make it great!

Materials:

- Small box
- Hot glue gun
- Green, purple, gold paint
- Green, purple, yellow feathers
- Flowers
- Gems
- Sequins





Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Make sure the ends of the box are all glued firmly shut. Have students paint the box however they would like.
- 3. Once the first coat is dry, let students paint on more details and add feathers, sequins, gems, and shapes. If you have cloth flowers, those can also be great on their boxes.
- 4. If they want to add people, you can use Lego people or make clay people.
- 5. They can also add string to the front to pull the float along like it is in a parade.
